## FLAGSHIP VERGELEGEN G.V.B. WHITE 2011

### Origin

The Semillon was planted in 1991 on the south facing Korhaan flats at 220m above sea level. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes used in this blend come from the 20-year old Schaapenberg vineyard. This single vineyard is planted some 320m above sea level and directly south facing. The row direction is east-west and the vineyards are planted to 2 clones, 316 and 317.

### Vinification

Both Semillon and Sauvignon grapes were hand-picked, the Semillon 2-3 weeks after the Sauvignon, whole bunch pressed and barrel fermented; the Semillon in 50% new, 50% 2nd, 3rd and 4th fill, 225 litre barrels and the Sauvignon in 500 litre barrels, 25% new. The wines were matured for 9 months before bottling on 1 December 2011.

### Composition

50% Schaapenberg Sauvignon Blanc  
50% Semillon

### Analysis

13.11% Alc  
2.6g/l RS  
6.9/l TA  
3.24 pH

### Maturation

Drink now or up to a decade after the vintage.

### Tasting Note

Pale green color with full ripe Semillon flavours dominating. The wine is rich and complex with a long aftertaste. Serve at 12-14°C. Most enjoyable with oysters, crayfish, poultry and fish.
