## FLAGSHIP VERGELEGEN G.V.B. WHITE 2014

### Origin

The Semillon was planted in 1991 on the south facing Korhaan flats at 220m above sea level. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes used in this blend come from the 20-year old Schaapenberg vineyard. This single vineyard is planted some 320m above sea level and directly south facing. The row direction is east-west and the vineyards are planted to 2 clones, 316 and 317.

### Vinification

Both Semillon and Sauvignon grapes were hand-picked, the Semillon a week after the Sauvignon, whole bunch pressed and barrel fermented; the Semillon in 30% new, 70% 2nd, 3rd and 4th fill, 225 litre barrels and the Sauvignon Blanc in 500 litre barrels, 25% new. The wines were matured for 8 months before bottling on 9 November 2014. Released June 2017.

### Composition

Semillon 50%  
Schaapenberg Sauvignon Blanc 50%

### Analysis

13.97% Alc  
2.1 g/l RS  
6.7 g/l TA  
3.18 pH

### Maturation

Drink now or up to a decade after the vintage.

### Tasting Note

Pale green color with full ripe Semillon flavours dominating. The wine is rich and complex with a long aftertaste. Serve at 12-14°C. Most enjoyable with oysters, crayfish, poultry and fish.
